Taylor Keogh was appointed in January 2012 as Glennmont's public affairs and local stakeholder engagement consultants. Our work has primarily focused on its new biomass-CHP asset, acquired from developers Eco2 – the Sleaford Renewable Energy Plant, Lincolnshire.

We established a Community Liaison Group and were tasked with delivering £280,000 worth of community funding over three years from January 2013, as part of a Well-Being Agreement with North Kesteven District Council (NKDC). In addition, we act as their first point of contact from media and stakeholders as well as being proactive in engaging with the local community.

Our public affairs work has involved advising on communications with DECC in regard to the grandfathering of biomass-CHP subsidy levels, which the Government decided to consult upon six months after Sleaford REP began construction.

Taylor Keogh has also been appointed on Glennmont's second biomass project in the UK – Margam Green Energy in South Wales.
